### “My Name is Deborah” Part 2—

Judges 4:13-16; 5:1-3, 8, 20-21, 31

What happens when everything **CLOSES IN**?

God **STEPS IN**.

*4:13 Sisera called together all his chariots, nine hundred iron chariots, and all the people who were with him . . . to the river Kishon.*

*5: 8b Not a shield or a spear was seen Among forty thousand in Israel.*

*14a Deborah said to Barak, “Arise! For this is the day in which the LORD has given Sisera into your hands; behold, the LORD has gone out before you.”*

*14b So Barak went down from Mount Tabor with ten thousand men following him.*

*5:20 “The stars fought from heaven, From their courses they fought against Sisera.*

*21 “The torrent of Kishon swept them away, The ancient torrent, the torrent Kishon. O my soul, march on with strength.*

*4:15a The LORD routed Sisera and all his chariots and all his army with the edge of the sword before Barak.*

Victory came through **GOD’S** intervention.

*16 Barak pursued the chariots and the army . . . and all the army of Sisera fell by the edge of the sword; not even one was left.*

Victory celebrates **FAITH** and praises **GOD**.

*5:1 Then Deborah and Barak . . . sang on that day, saying,*

*2 “That the leaders led in Israel, That the people volunteered, Bless the LORD!*

*3 “Hear, O kings; give ear, O rulers! I—to the LORD, I will sing, I will sing praise to the LORD, the God of Israel.*

*31 “Thus let all Your enemies perish, O LORD;*

*But let those who love Him be like the rising of the sun in its might.”*

*And the land was undisturbed for forty years.*

**This petition will be granted in the Day of the Lord:**

*Malachi 4:1 “For behold, the day is coming, burning like a furnace; and all the arrogant and every evildoer will be chaff; and the day that is coming will set them ablaze,” says the LORD of hosts, “so that it will leave them neither root nor branch.”*

*2 “But for you who fear My name, the sun of righteousness will rise with healing in its wings; and you will go forth and skip about like calves from the stall.*
